Cybersecurity Alert

Recently, the White House issued a warning that there may be an increased risk of a cyber-attack on the private sector due to the ongoing conflict in Ukraine. The warning stated that now is the time for companies to harden their online defenses. We know many of you have already increased your cyber security over the years. Here are some things you can do to lesson your chance of being affected by a potential cyber-attack:

1. Implement multi-factor authentication on your accounts to make it less likely you will get hacked.
2. Update your software and turn on automatic updates.
3. Think before you click. More than 90% of successful cyber-attacks start with a phishing email. If you receive a suspicious email, DO NOT REPLY OR OPEN. Rather, contact the person who sent the email to determine if the email is authentic or not.
4. Use strong passwords with combinations of upper and lower-case letters, numbers, and symbols.

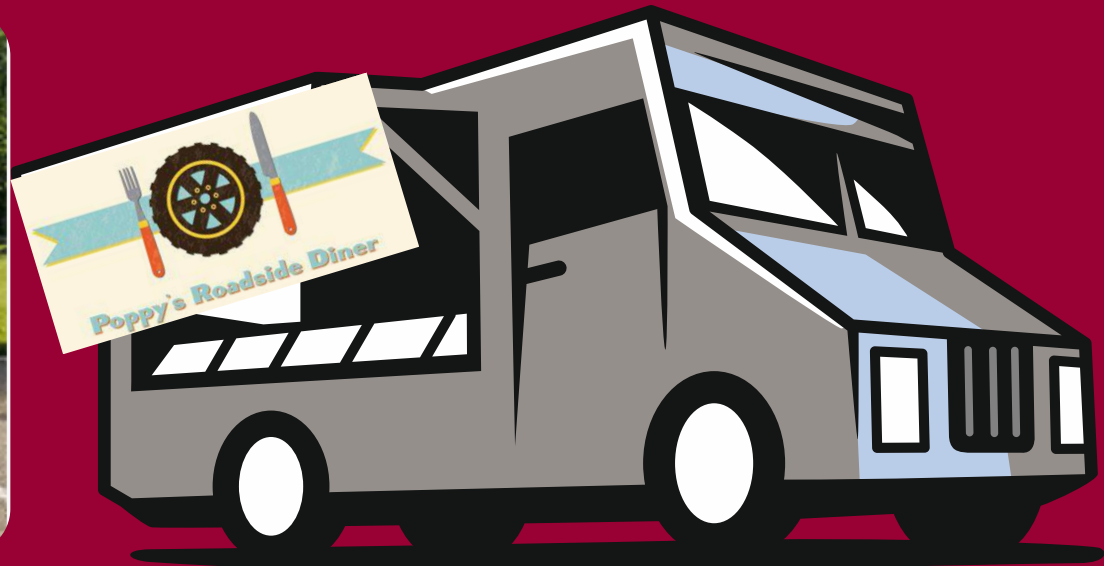
